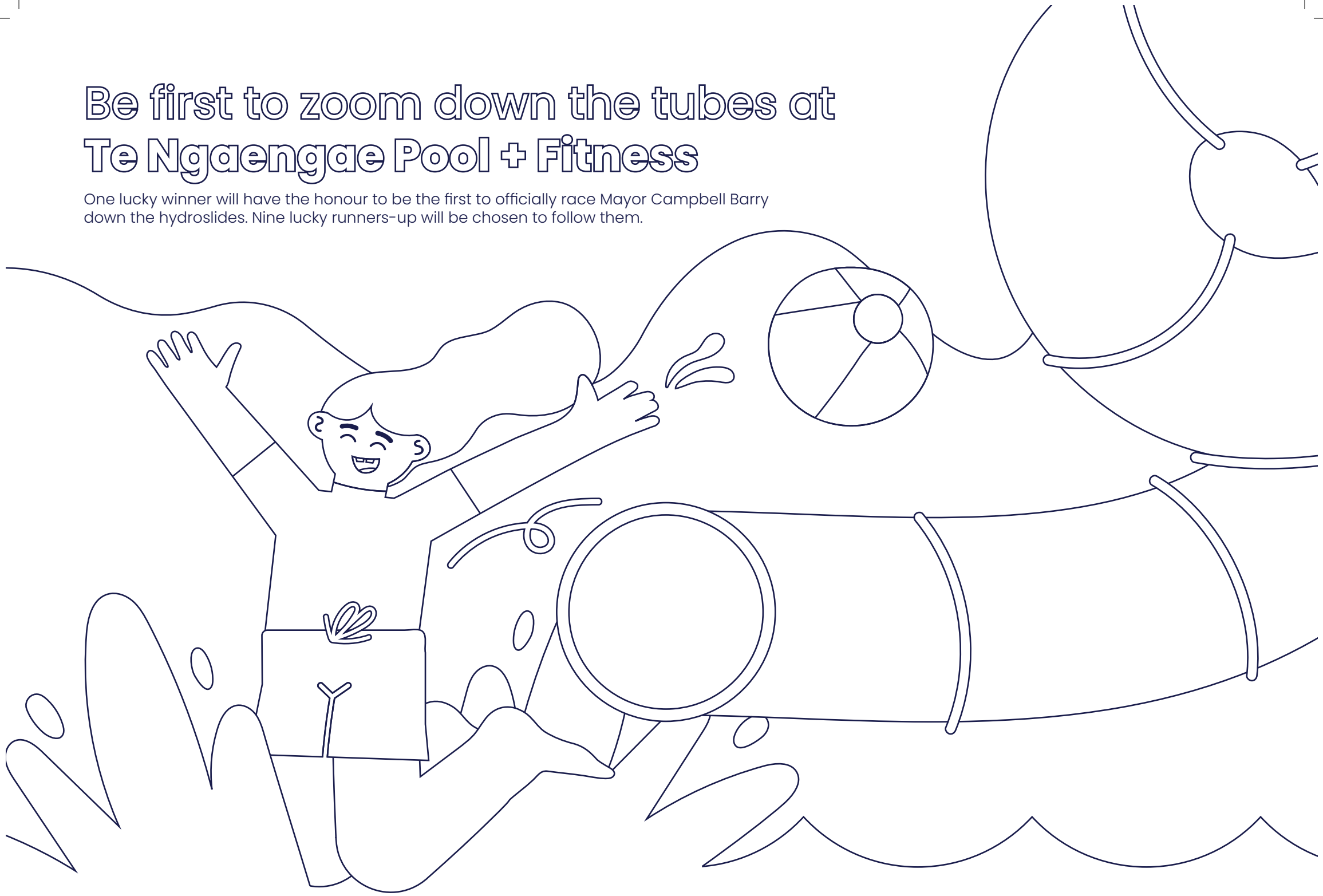


Be first to zoom down the tubes at Te Ngaengae Pool + Fitness

How to enter:

- Entry must be submitted for judging by 5pm on 22 November.
- The Mayor will judge all entries based on creativity and artistic merit.

Announcement of winners:

Winner and runners-up will be announced on 29 November and contacted via phone call. They will then go on to be announced on the Mayor's and Hutt City Council's social media channels.

We require your name and contact information as part of your entry to the competition. If these are not provided, your entry will not be presented to the Mayor for judging.

Terms and conditions:

- I give consent for my child's name and artwork (colouring in) to be used publicly on social and other media, and on physical display.
- I confirm the entrant is willing and able to slide down the zoom tube either by themselves or with a parent/guardian. Younger children can go down the Zoom tubes with their parents.
- Unaccompanied children need to be 1.1m tall.
- Entry is open to all people 18 years old or younger.
- Winners will need to be available on Saturday 7 December at 9:15am to be ready to Zoom!

Privacy statement:

We're collecting your personal information so we can contact you if your child wins a prize. If you choose not to enter contact details, we'll be unable to submit your entry for judging.

Your information will be held in a locked container at Naenae Neighbourhood Hub until the winner is selected. Email submissions will be printed, added to the secure container and then deleted. If your entry is chosen, your details will be entered and held in secure Hutt City Council (HCC) systems until no longer required. Only authorised HCC staff have access to your information.

The child's name and artwork (colouring in) may be used by HCC in any publicity or advertising in print and electronic media such as websites, social media, print, digital advertising, and other advertising. If you choose not to provide your personal details, or approval to use the entry, HCC will not use them.

Unsuccessful entries will be displayed in Naenae Neighbourhood Hub for two weeks after the competition closing date. Entrants may collect their submission during this time or they will be securely disposed of.
